School Garden	<p>Last year the school received a grant of £1000 from Persimmon's homes to improve the wildlife garden so it could be more usefully used as an outdoor learning space. The children had some ideas for designs and a few parents helped clear the area last spring but nothing further has happened.</p> <p>Mrs Puszczynska has been trying to get quotes for a landscaper to look at the garden. However, no-one approached is interested, quoting reasons such as no insurance to work on school site, and no DBS checks.</p> <p>We were unclear whether there were specific terms attached to the money received from Persimmon's. Could the money be used for the outdoor games tables that have already been purchased? Were there any conditions attached to the grant. Also, we did not know whether any designs have been produced.
