Place a number of items (up to 8) of clothing, mobile phone, toys, food, etc and try to put the items in order of value. Why did you choose the items you did and why did you put them in the order? Record your ideas.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Geography</p> <p>Look at an Ordnance Survey map of your area. What symbols can you spot? Can you find: The school? Your town/village? A church? (Tower or spire?) A post office? A castle? Parking? A footpath? A public convenience? What else can you spot? Is there anything that surprised you?</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">RE</p> <p>Listen to “What a wonderful World” sung by Louis Armstrong and/or find a copy of the lyrics. Consider what makes the world <i>wonderful</i> in the song. What makes the world special for you? Record your ideas in pictures and writing.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">Art</p> <p>Can you make a rainbow with natural materials?</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>Find out about sounds that are too high-pitched or low-pitched for humans to hear. Which animals can make these special sounds? What are these sorts of sounds used for?</p>
