The charity that we supported, Teams4U, sent a total of 64,045 shoeboxes to children in Eastern Europe, an increase of 1,471 from 2022. Some of the warehouse volunteers went to help deliver the shoeboxes bringing some joy to children who would otherwise have received nothing at Christmas!
